From Synod— The Annual meeting of Synod agreed to appoint Nicola Grundy to its leadership team for 2023. Nicola will be Synod Superintendent 50% of her time, the other 50% will be the parish. The Synod also made a nomination for President and Vice President. Te Aroha Rountre, a lay woman from Tamaki Rohe, lecturer in Moana and Māori studies at Trinity College for President, and Rev Peter Norman, Parish Superintendent Northcote Takapuna Methodist Parish for Vice President. Carol Dale and Alan Dine were reappointed to the Synod Property Committee.

Election Forum—The Living Wage Forum is planning to host an election forum on Wednesday 14th September. This will be held at St Peters, Willis Street.


A way of offering some immediate help to DCM is through re-stocking their foodbank. Some of the items they most need include:
