Lenten Studies

We will be holding a series of Lenten Studies from the week beginning 7th March. There will be a zoom series held on Wednesday evenings (led by Philip Garside) and a face to face session held on Thursdays at 10:30am in the vestry (led by Nicola). If you would like to attend either of these please let Nicola know.

The material we will be using is called "Witness at the Cross" and it is written by Amy-Jill Levine, University Professor of New Testament and Jewish Studies from Vanderbilt Divinity School. There will be six session and we will experience Holy Friday from the perspective of those who watched Jesus die:

- * Mary his mother
- * The Beloved Disciple from the Gospel of John
- * Mary Magdalene and the other women from Galilee
- * The two men, usually identified as thieves, crucified with Jesus
- * The centurion and the soldiers
- * Joseph of Arimathea and Nicodemus.
