Christian World Service – Ukraine Crisis Appeal

CWS, the aid agency associated with the Methodist Church, is appealing for donations to assist people displaced by the war in Ukraine. In Hungary, Poland, Romania, Slovakia and Ukraine, ACT Alliance (Action by Churches Together) is providing water, food, shelter, blankets and more to families who have left their homes, jobs and loved ones. As we are seen on our tv screens, it is cold outside, and many people are traumatised and afraid. UNHCR reports 3.6 million people have already fled Ukraine and 6.5 million have fled their homes but remain in Ukraine (internally displaced).
